Terms and conditions

1. Organizer

The organizer of the summer school is the Department of Thermal Engineering, Faculty of Energy and Environmental Engineering, Silesian University of Technology in Gliwice (Poland).

2. Participant

Participants in the summer school may be PhD students with academic background in mechanical engineering, energy system engineering and environmental engineering.

3. The date and place of summer school

The summer school will be held on 24-28.08.2020 at the premises of Silesian University of Technology.

Address of the school venue is Konarskiego 22, 44-100 Gliwice, Poland.

4. Goals of the summer school

- a) Transfer of knowledge on recent developments in science and technology, which pave the way towards a low-carbon future. The scope of the school will cover recent developments in the areas of technologies and methodologies. Participants will get familiar with contemporary trends in the development of methods and technologies for energy transition and climate protection. Special focus will be given to on-going European research development projects.
- b) Networking at international level.

5. Application procedure

a) The candidate who wants to take part in the summer school sends his application to the

organizer of the summer school by completing the registration form, which is available on the website: www.etcp.polsl.pl/registration

- b) By submitting his application, the candidate accepts the terms & conditions of summer school.
- c) By submitting his application, the candidate accepts the privacy policy and agrees with the organizer to process and place his personal data contained in the application in the database of the Silesian University of Technology. Personal data of the candidate will be processed only by the organizer and only for needs of the summer school organization.
- d) After the organizer has received the application, the candidate receives information about the registration of the application.
- e) The candidate receives the agreement form on the terms of payment for the training, together with the data for payment transfer which he is obliged to accept and sign.
- f) The candidate is obliged to make the payment by **18/06/2021**. After the payment is received by the organiser, the candidate receives a written confirmation by e-mail about the admission to the summer school.

6. Fee

- a) The cost of participation in the summer school is 3440 PLN or 800 EUR per person.
- b) The fee can be paid in PLN of EUR.
- c) The price includes the fee for:
 - participation in all classes and laboratory demonstrations
 - · coffee breaks and lunches
 - two evening dinners/social events
 - school materials in printed and electronic form
- d) Participants pay their own travel costs to the place of training and return journey to their place of residence, individual insurance (for travel and stay), as well as costs related to obtaining a visa.

- f) The lack of the full payment fee by the participant by **18/06/2021** is treated as resignation from participation in the summer school.
- g) All candidates should withhold the booking of flight tickets and planning the trip to the summer school, until they receive a final confirmation from the organizer about the and the start of the summer school. Such information will be sent to all accepted participants not later than by 31/03/2021.

7. Rules for the implementation of the summer school

- a) Participants of the summer school are obliged to attend classes and take active part in additional activities planned by the organizers.
- b) If the participant completes the summer school program, he / she obtains 3 points.

ECTS confirmed by a certificate.

c) In the case of severe restrictions on mobility due to pandemic situation related to COVID-19, the Summer School is planned to take place fully on-line or in hybrid mode. The basic option is however, the on-site event.

8. The organizer's right to cancel the summer school

The organizer reserves the right to cancel the summer school if the minimum number of participants is not collected. If the minimum number of participants is not collected until 31/03/2021, the organizer notifies by e-mail the accepted candidate about not opening the summer school and in case the participant has already paid his / her fee, the University returns to the participant the whole amount of the paid fee.

9. Participant's right to resign from participation

The accepted candidate who paid the fee for participation in the summer school may withdraw his application on a written request:

- a) until 18/06/2021 without any additional costs. Then the full amount of the fee will be refunded to the participant on the account provided by him.
- b) after 18/06/2021 the payment will not be refunded to the participant.







10. Visa

- a) At the request of the participant, the organizer issues an invitation for the purposes of applying for a visa.
- b) Each participant on his own is applying for a visa and covers all costs related to obtaining a visa.

11. Additional arrangements

- a) The organizer is not responsible for the timely delivery of correspondence sent by the polish post or e-mail.
- b) In matters not covered by these Regulations, the provisions of the Civil Code, the Act on the Protection of Personal Data and the Law on Copyright and Related Rights shall apply.
